I. The Promise of Judgment v3

1. They were Condemned Long Ago

Jude 4 *For certain people have crept in unnoticed who long ago were designated for this condemnation, ungodly people, who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ.*

1. The Fall of the Angels v4

Jude 6-7 *And the angels who did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day— just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding cities, which **likewise** indulged in sexual immorality and pursued unnatural desire, serve as an example by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire.*

Genesis 6:1-4

Num 13:33 *And there we saw the Nephilim (the sons of Anak, who come from the Nephilim), and we seemed to ourselves like grasshoppers, and so we seemed to them."*

2. The Flood of Judgment v5

Genesis 6:5-8

Jude 14-15 *It was also about these that Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with ten thousands of his holy ones, to execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness that they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him."*

Gen 5:24 *Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him.*

Heb 11:5 *By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him*

3. The Fire of Judgment v6-8

James 3:1 *Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness.*
